GREEN CHAMPIONS AWARD	For composting achievements that diverted 15,790 lbs. of pre- and post-consumer cafeteria waste from the landfill, while reducing greenhouse gases, such as methane and carbon dioxide, normally produced during waste decomposition. In FY2010, over 95 percent of the Institute's total cafeteria waste was either composted or recycled, surpassing the NIEHS 2010 Environmental Management System goal of 10,000 pounds.
